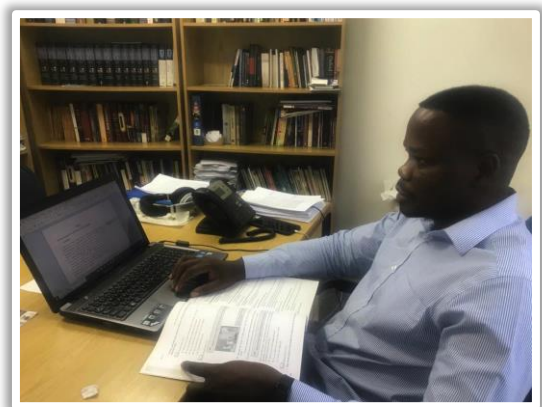

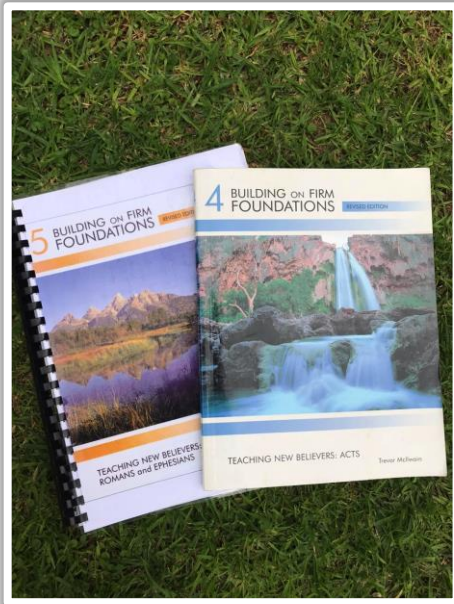


*Translating Materials*

## My Ministry

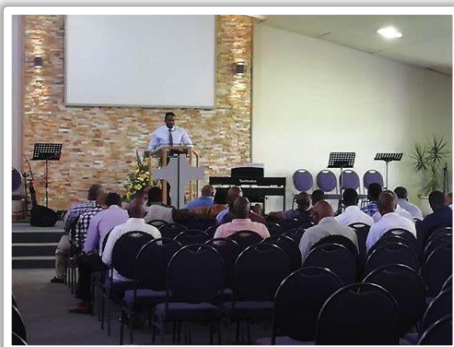
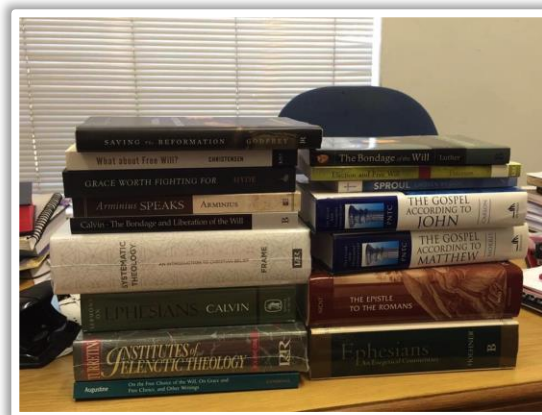
Our commitment to biblical contextualisation and indigenisation has called for more engagements with the translation of materials. Universal missionary experience has shown that dependence on foreign leadership is deadly to the health, growth and multiplication of churches. Therefore, we are committed to the classical missiological principles of indigeneity. Church in Mozambique should be self-governing, self-propagating and self-theologizing as quickly as possible. We want leaders in Mozambique to take more teaching responsibilities for the health of the church.

The abovementioned need meets with a challenge of lack of materials in the Xitsonga Language, which produced a desire within the mission to be more intentional about it and that would call for me to spend more hours translating and writing resources toward the accomplishment of those goals. The major project would be translating book 4 of Building on the Firm Foundation which is a survey of the book of Acts and books 5 which is a survey of the book of Ephesians. We continue to strive for effectiveness in Mozambique and this year we are more particularised than any other year we have been serving God in the area of our ministry.



## My Life

For personal growth as well as for the benefit of our ministry I have decided to further my studies and so this year I have added studying to my already busy and hard ministry schedule.
